Summary

MMX is pleased to announce its partnership with Nominet in providing the registry services and technical support to the registrar channels for the portfolio of MMX top level domains (TLDs) listed below:

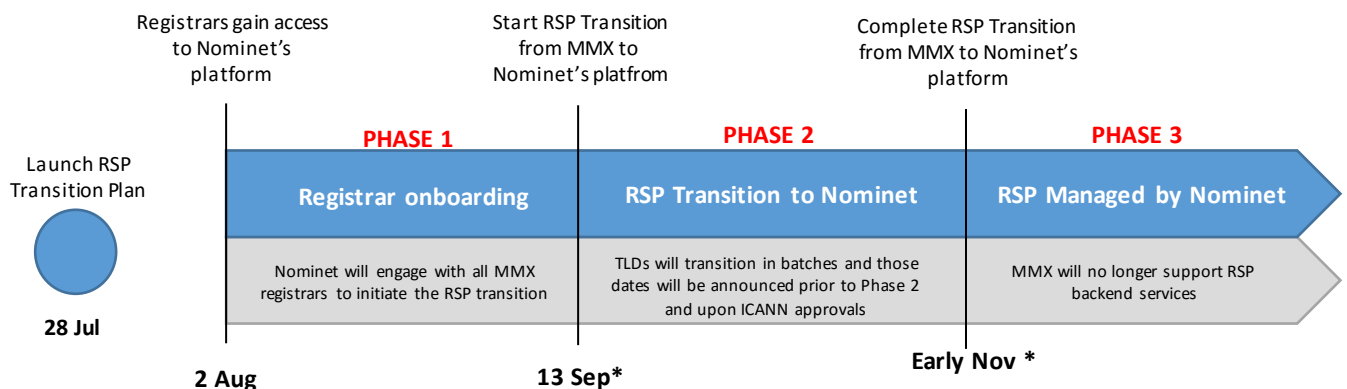

As we continue to work through the ICANN processes, we will provide updates to the RSP transition through this site. We expect the RSP transitions to commence in mid-September 2016, and hope to announce a firm date of those RSP transitions across our portfolio of top-level domains within the coming weeks.

General Timeline

We intend to handle the RSP Transition in three major phases as illustrated below:



*Note: Dates are contingent upon ICANN approvals and may be subject to change.

Phase 1 Next Steps: Registrar Onboarding

1. Nominet sent out email notifications to the registrar technical contacts stored in Espresso on 02 August 2016 and subsequent emails as identified in the "Nominet Communication" section below.
2. Registrars must (1) log into Nominet's [Online Services](#) portal, (2) configure the operational IP addresses for EPP connections, and (3) access Nominet's OT&E prior to the TLD transitions. To mitigate any transition issues, please ensure these activities are completed prior to 06 September 2016.

3. Nominet will continue to work with all registrars prior to the start of each TLD transition with details on actions to be performed.
